

Western Reserve Carriage Association announces an opportunity to take the Carriage Association of America Drivers Proficiency Program Tests level I or level 2 and the road assessment.

In keeping with the goals of our organization of safety and education the WRCA has made arrangements for an evaluator to come to our area to administer level I, road driving assessment and units 2, 3 and 4 of level II of the drivers proficiency program. By participating in this evaluation you can earn a CAA Driver Proficiency Certificate and pin.

Jerry Trapani of East Islip, New York who is an instructor and evaluator of levels 1 2& 3, will be on site. This is made possible through the cooperation of the CAA, Lake Farmpark and sponsorship of WRCA. We are limited to 15 spots for the three-day period. In order to take advantage of this evaluation opportunity you must sign up soon. The procedures are explained below.

Evaluations

There are a limited number of time spots (15) for the evaluations. They will be scheduled on a first-come basis with Western Reserve members accepted first.

Cost

- Level 1 75.00 and/or 30.00 for road test check made out to CAA and 35.00 fees to help cover costs of bringing evaluator to our area check made out to WRCA
Non-members of CAA 85.00 and 30.00 for road test check made out to CAA
Non-WRCA members 70.00 fee to cover costs of bringing evaluator to area check made out to WRCA.
- Level 2 CAA members only 75.00 per unit. Only units 2,3,4 offered check made out to CAA 35.00 fees to cover costs of bringing evaluator to our area check made out to WRCA

No stabling is available at the Farmpark and all horse owners will need to sign a statement that the equines have been vaccinated within the last year for flu and rhino. Overnight stabling will be available off site, for information contact Ann Petersen

The procedure is to contact Jill Ryder at the CAA and she will forward you an application for the Drivers Proficiency program.
